
2018 Millage Rate

This year the millage rate was again impacted by the Headlee Rollback. After making the calculations provided to us by Livingston County Equalization, the maximum millage we can now levy for the Operating millage is 8.3175 (down from the previous 8.3897 mills). The maximum millage we can levy for Highway also decreased and is now 4.1247, however, we will still only be levying 4.0000 mills. The total mills levied for the 2018 tax year will be 12.3175.

2018 Taxes

Taxes will be accepted without interest or penalty until the due date of Friday, September 14, 2018 at 4pm. Payments can be made via mail or in person. Credit card or debit card payments can't be made at Village Hall but can be done online at villageofpinckney.org (There is a 3% fee for online payments). A drop box is to the right of the front door at Village Hall as an after-hours option. If mailing your taxes, keep in mind that postmarks are NOT accepted.

Have you been participating in the new Simple Recycling program?

Using the orange recycling bags, you are able to recycle clothing and housewares right along with your regular recycling. Fill the bags with items that are not fit for resale and they will grade and sort materials, locally and/or regionally, based on quality and condition. The top quality materials will be resold to local thrift outlets, mid grade is exported to international markets and "unusable" items are processed for raw materials.

There is no cost to the village or its residents to participate. The best part? For every pound of material that is picked up, the Village of Pinckney receives \$.01. One hundred percent of the monies received from Simple Recycling goes toward our Parks fund!
