 - All excavations for sewer connections in the street must conform to the Sewer Ordinance and/or Water Ordinance, and the Village Technical Standards.
 - Water and sewer connections on private property must be inspected and approved by the Livingston County Building Department.
 - Contractor is responsible for all barricading and traffic control and must conform with MIOSHA standards and Michigan Traffic Control laws.
