## AGENDA ITEMS:

1. FY2019/20 Budget  
The committee reviewed the draft of the PPD FY2019/20 Budget. Much of the discussion centered on part-time payroll and vehicle maintenance cost. Chief explained that the budget is a draft that will be completed for presentation to the Budget Committee on April 3, 2019. Corrections will be made on the 2019 Charger maintenance line and the DPW labor line.
2. Status of Byrne/JAG Grant  
With the purchase of then 2019 Charger, one new in-car video system and body camera has been placed into service. These systems have been placed into service early. The remainder of the system won't be up and running until late April or early May, 2019. So far the department is in the early learning stages of the system. We are getting used to having a body camera and learning how / where to place it, and use it. Chief explained that based on the early use, and its limited ability, the new system is going to be a great improvement to the old system.
3. Caprice pay-out
  - a. Equipment Proposal  
The Chief presented a proposal to buy new radios and radars using the insurance payout from the 2014 Caprice. The village should be getting a total of \$37,347 from the insurance. Prior to the insurance pay-out, the village transferred \$13,000 from several PPD cash funds, zeroing them out. The proposal is that village use the \$13,000 for the radars and radios. Presented were two quotes: One for \$7,950 for three (3) Kenwood radios and accessories, and one for \$6,810 for three (3) Stalker radar devices.
