2020 RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read the following instructions before completing and returning your parade application.

No objects including candy, flyers, or favors, may be THROWN out along the entire parade route or in the staging area. Michigan State Law prohibits throwing of items in a parade. Items can be handed out (parade attendees can walk along the float)

1. No unit will be admitted into the parade that has not been pre-approved. Entries will NOT be accepted or considered after Wednesday, March 5, 2020.
2. The Pinckney St. Patrick's Day Parade Committee reserves the right to reject any entry that is not in good taste, inappropriate, or not in the best interest of the community
3. Entries depicting a controversial issue will not be considered.
4. Maximum height for entries is 12.6 feet from the ground. Maximum width is 8.6 feet.
5. All units are required to maintain forward motion at all times. No maneuvers are allowed that slows the forward movement of the parade.
6. All entries should be properly identified with signs or banners with the organization's name so the spectators know who you are.
7. Drivers of motorized vehicles must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license. The Pinckney St. Patrick's Day Parade Coordinator must see the driver's license prior to parade start.
8. Only one powered vehicle will be permitted for each entry.
9. A maximum of 363 walkers is permitted to walk with your entry. The walkers must be able to keep up with the pace and length (approximately .8 mile of the parade).
10. Equestrian and animal units must provide their own accompanying clean-up personnel and equipment. Please make sure the horses have the proper shoes.
11. All parade participants are required to conduct themselves in such a manner as not to infringe on the rights of those people living in and along the staging areas and parade route. NO solicitation is allowed during event.
12. Applications must be received by Wednesday, March 5, 2020. However, the size of the parade is limited to 1099 entries.
