**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDS UNDER THE STANDARD ALLOWANCE FOR REVENUE LOSS FOR WATER METER RADIO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the **American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA)** established the **Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF)** program to provide funding to state and local governments to respond to the economic and public health impacts of the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, the **United States Department of Treasury Final Rule** permits recipients to elect a **Standard Allowance for Revenue Loss of up to \$10,000,000**, which may be used to provide **government services** without the need for detailed revenue loss calculations; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Pinckney has elected to utilize the **Standard Allowance for Revenue Loss** under the Treasury Final Rule, thereby allowing the use of ARPA funds for the provision of government services; and

WHEREAS, eligible government services include the **maintenance and improvement of infrastructure, including water system infrastructure and public rights-of-way improvements**; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to utilize a portion of its ARPA funds for infrastructure improvements that support essential municipal services and benefit the residents of the Village of Pinckney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Council of the **Village of Pinckney** hereby authorizes the expenditure of **Seventy-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Forty Seven Dollars and Twenty Four Cents (\$79,347.24)** from ARPA **Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds** allocated under the **Standard Allowance for Revenue Loss** for the purchase and installation of **water meter radios for the Village of Pinckney water system**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **Village Council hereby allocates any remaining ARPA funds received by the Village for necessary sidewalk repairs**, which constitute eligible **government services**, to be expended during **Fiscal Year 2025–2026**.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Pinckney Village Council and publication in accordance with applicable law.
