ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF PINCKNEY CODE OF
ORDINANCES BY AMENDING TITLE III: ADMINISTRATION;
CHAPTER 30: VILLAGE OFFICIALS

The Village of Pinckney ordains:

Section 1. Title III, *ADMINISTRATION*, Chapter 30, *Village Officials*, of the Village of Pinckney Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to add a new Section 30.03, entitled *Compensation of Officers*, to read as follows:

§ 30.03 COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS.

(A) President and Trustees. The President and Trustees shall each receive compensation as established by resolution of the Council, which shall be adopted no less than annually simultaneously with the annual budget of the village. Such compensation may include a base salary, or a per diem rate for attending Council meetings and other meetings in fulfillment of the duties of the President and Trustees, or both. The resolution may also provide for reimbursement of any expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties pursuant to policies as may be established from time to time by resolution of the Village Council.

(B) Time of payment; other conditions. The President and Trustees shall be paid monthly. The Council may, by resolution, authorize the President or a Trustee to perform, with or without compensation, other additional services for the Village that are not within the normal official duties of the President or Trustee offices as may be deemed appropriate by the majority of the Council. Any compensation for such additional services shall increase the President or Trustee compensation only during the time periods that Council has authorized such additional services. The President or Trustees shall receive no other compensation for their official duties as President or Trustee services performed for and on behalf of the village during the term of office except compensation provided by a resolution adopted pursuant to this section.

(C) Other officials and employees. All other village officers and employees shall receive such compensation as the Council may from time to time establish by resolution or contracts of employment.

Section 2. Repealer Clause. Village of Pinckney Ordinance 39, as amended, and any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 3. Savings Clause. This ordinance shall in no manner affect pending litigation, either civil or criminal, founded or growing out of any ordinance, resolution, order or parts thereof, hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall in no manner affect any

rights, claims, privileges, immunities or causes of action of the Village, County or other person, either criminal or civil, that may have already occurred, accrued or grown out of any ordinance, resolution, order or policy, or any part thereof, hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall in no manner affect pending litigation, either civil or criminal, founded or growing out of any Ordinance, Resolution, Order or parts thereof, hereby repealed.

Section 4. Validity and Severability. Should any portion of this Ordinance be found invalid for any reason, such a holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its publication.
