2026 CHICKEN PERMIT RENEWAL

March 25, 2026

There are several changes this year for village chicken owners. In September 2025, Village Council passed Ordinance #178 (attached). In summary, to keep hens in the village, there will be a \$25 one time fee for 2026, which **auto renews** each year *without further cost*.

Maximum number of chickens allowed now depends on lot size. You may have up to 5 chickens per ¼ acre (roughly the size of an average single downtown village lot) with a maximum number of 15 chickens. You may also own one rooster, if your lot size is approximately ½ acre or more. However, rooster owners must renew their permit every year.

Below is the information on file with the Village. Please verify the information below and remit the one time fee of \$25 for hens, and a \$25 yearly fee for your rooster (if applicable). Please respond with payment prior to April 30, 2026. A renewal form is also available online at villageofpinckney.org.
