A RESOLUTION TO APPLY A 10% DELAYED PAYMENT CHARGE TO
VILLAGE UTILITY BILLS, INCLUDING REFUSE, LEAF, AND BRUSH
COLLECTION CHARGES

WHEREAS, the Village of Pinckney bills customers for water and sewer service and may include charges for refuse, leaf, and brush collection on Village utility bills; and

WHEREAS, Village Code §§ 51.11(B)(4) and 52.35(A)(4) provide for a 10% delayed payment charge when billed water and sewer charges are not paid by day 30 following the mailing of the bill; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council intends to apply a consistent 10% delayed payment charge to all billed utility services, including any separately billed refuse, leaf, and brush collection charges;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Village staff shall apply and collect the 10% delayed payment charge on unpaid water and sewer charges in accordance with the Village Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Council approves applying the same 10% delayed payment charge to refuse, leaf, and brush collection charges **when those charges appear on a Village utility bill.** Application of the delayed payment charge to those services shall begin only after the necessary Village Code amendment expressly authorizing it has taken effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, once authorized, the 10% delayed payment charge shall apply to unpaid water, sewer, refuse, leaf, and brush collection charges that remain unpaid by day 30 following the mailing of the utility bill. The charge shall be applied once to the applicable billed service charges and shall not be compounded on previously assessed late charges.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution does not create a new charge for leaf or brush pickup. Village staff shall clearly identify the payment deadline and delayed payment charge on utility bills and administer the charge in accordance with the Village Code.
