POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET AMENDMENT - TASER CAPITAL OUTLAY**

At a regular meeting of the Village Council held September 28, 2026.

WHEREAS, the Village Council previously approved the purchase of Tasers for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police submitted a budget amendment request dated September 15, 2026, to move existing Police Department appropriations into capital outlay account 101.301.980 for that purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Uniform Budgeting and Accounting Act, MCL 141.437, provides for amendment of the general appropriations act when a change in appropriations is necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Council approves the following amendment to the fiscal year 2026-2027 Police Department budget within the General Fund:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this amendment reallocates \$6,000 within the existing Police Department budget. It does not increase the department's total appropriation, the General Fund's total appropriation, or the tax levy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Treasurer shall verify that the reductions are available and unencumbered and shall record the approved changes in the Village's budget records. The prior approval of the Taser purchase remains subject to applicable purchasing procedures and available appropriations.
