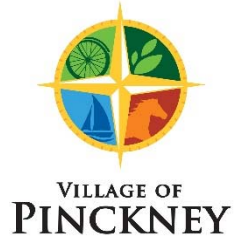

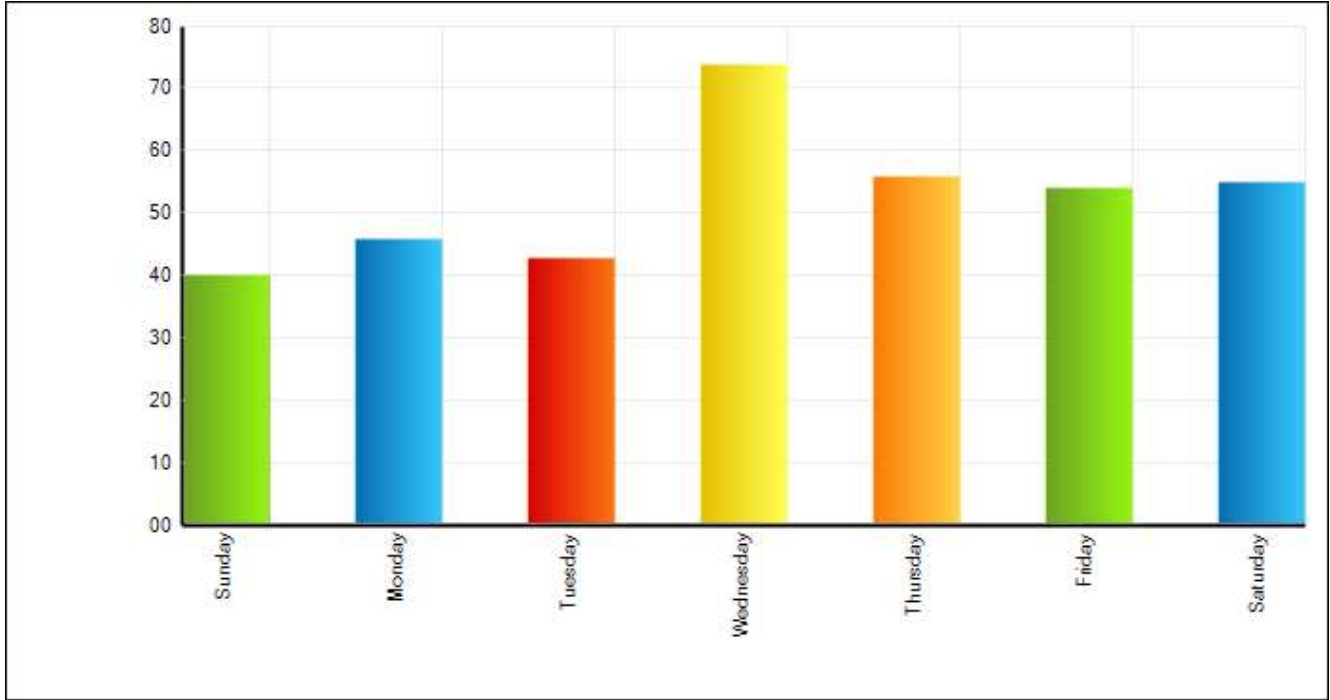

Miscellaneous:

- The following permits have been issued since the last report:
 - 9 Waivers (various siding, re-roof, driveway seal)
 - 1 Right-of-way permit (driveway)
 - 6 LUP (decks, fences & sheds plus antenna equipment for T-Mobile on existing tower)
 - 3 Sign Permits

Code Enforcement:

- I still do not have a court date yet for the violations at the residence with multiple junk vehicles across from The Means Project on M-36. Although they have removed several vehicles, I am still not satisfied with the condition of the property.
- The attempted delivery of the certified letter with the municipal civil infraction was refused by the homeowner for the violations involving rubbish, etc. on the front porch area of the home on W. Main. The Police Department has posted the notice on the property in order to move forward.
- Mr. Frank Collins who spoke several times during public forum of the Planning Commission has sent me several complaints/requests for compliance of junk vehicles and other violations. I have gotten some compliance by simply speaking to the homeowner and others have been sent letters of violations.

Planning Commission:

- The Planning Commission meeting has been canceled due to lack of business. I will be putting together the next set of ordinance amendments that had been discussed at the joint Council/Planning Commission meeting. I should be ready to present something at the next PC meeting.
- Project Updates
 - 425 Dexter – Special Land Use: The Special Land Use extension was granted for six months expiring December 7, 2022. I have spoken with Mr. Black on several occasions about his intent to submit a site plan. If you recall, when he appeared before the Commission for the extension, he indicated that he was “close” to submittal. I have informed him that the clearing of the property and the use of the property is not consistent with the process as he does not have an approved site plan. I do expect to see a plan in October.
 - Trufit: Based on the applicant's desire to move into the building as quickly as possible, the Commission did approve both the preliminary and final site plan at the same time back in May of this year. Their desire was to reach an agreement with the Village to allow occupancy with the paving of the lot in the spring of next year. An acceptable agreement has not been submitted nor have they completed the required items contained in the engineering review. I have had no contact with the applicant since July.
 - The Means Project: They have received a Land Use Permit and are continuing to work on the building & site.
 - Lakeland Knoll: Village Council granted an extension of the condominium development on August 8th. (Council has jurisdiction of the site condominium approval & extension – not the Planning Commission unlike other special land use requests). Mr. Blau indicated in a recent email that he is making progress on the emergency access driveway at the end of Pond Street as requested by the Fire Department, which is what has been holding up the project.

He has been working with the Village Engineer on the Traffic Impact Study and water and sewer issues.

DDA:

- Spooktacular: Don McColl of the Rotary Club was present at the October 3rd meeting to discuss funding of the Spooktacular event. The Board approved the payment for the tents to be used for the event.
- Light Up the Park: We have been unable to find a group or organization willing to sponsor the Light Up the Park Event. The Board feels that with members of the Board as well as other volunteers (hopefully), it can conduct a successful event.
 - Date: I have spoken with Putnam Township about holding the event in the Park on Saturday December 3rd. It is the weekend after the big Howell Parade of lights and early enough to kick off the season without interfering with people's busy holiday schedule.
 - Holiday Decorating Contest – Prizes: One of the events that I believe has been done in the past and is a good way to get participation from our business community is a Holiday Decorating Contest. I have included that in the DDA Newsletter as well. The Board has authorized the purchase of gift cards from local businesses for the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners
 - Sponsorships: We will contact the Chamber as well as other groups and businesses for sponsorship and will attempt to find a unique way to recognize and market those businesses that do.
 - Other Events: We will be coordinating other events such as Santa arriving, pictures/cookies & milk with Santa, possibly getting high school band and/or choir, tree decorating, etc. and of course, refreshments from our local merchants. There is time to get these ideas and others in motion. I will be able to provide better detail and costs at the next meeting.
 - I am hoping that our businesses will be open during the event and take the opportunity to participate and promote their business.
- DDA Boundary: At the October 3rd DDA meeting, the board discussed the possible areas of expansion of the DDA boundary. There are a couple of areas that are in question (the Post Office property & Village Hall property). Although, there may be some public benefit in having these properties in the district, they are tax-exempt governmental properties, which is why I am sure they were left out of the district originally. There would be no tax capture or other benefit in having them included. The ultimate decision and corresponding ordinance amendment would be Council's with a recommendation from the DDA Board. Preliminarily, the feel of the Board was that the Post Office property and then the Autozone/Fitness property adjacent to the Post Office would make sense, but the Village Hall property should remain outside of the district.
