## ORDINANCE NO. 160

## ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF PINCKNEY CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING TITLE XV, LAND USAGE, CHAPTER 152, ZONING, § 152.388, GENERAL APPLICATION STANDARDS

## THE VILLAGE OF PINCKNEY ORDAINS:

- Subsection (B)(3) of Section 152.388, General Application Standards; Chapter 152, Zoning; Title XV, Land Usage, of the Village of Pinckney Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - (3) Site plan. A site plan in compliance with § 152.389 (preliminary) or § 152.391 (final), as applicable and conforming to Village Technical Standards.
  - (a) The applicant shall submit four individually folded copies of the site plan on 24-inch by 36-inch sheets and one digital copy. See Village Zoning Administrator for format details.
  - (b) The site plan shall be drawn to scale of not less than one inch = 20 feet for property under three acres and not more than one inch = 50 feet for sites three acres or more.
- Section 2. Subsection (C) of Section 152.388, General Application Standards; Chapter 152, Zoning; Title XV, Land Usage, of the Village of Pinckney Code of Ordinances, is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - (C) Submission. A complete application must be submitted to the Zoning Administrator at least thirty (30) business days prior to the Planning Commission meeting at which the proposal will first be considered.
- <u>Section 3.</u> <u>Repealer Clause.</u> All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.
- <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Savings Clause.</u> This Ordinance does not affect rights and duties matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were begun, before its effective date.
- Section 5. Validity and Severability. Should any portion of this Ordinance be found invalid for any reason, such a holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
- Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective twenty (20) days from and after its publication.
