RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH REQUIREMENTS FOR HYDRANT RENTAL AND WATER SALES OUTSIDE NORMAL RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL USAGE

DATE: September 25, 2023

WHEREAS; each year the village is contacted by crews for hydrant rental for construction within the village, construction just outside the village and water to be hauled to other locales:

WHEREAS; the village currently has a hydrant rental policy that was designed for village limits construction projects and municipal fire department training only;

WHEREAS; Ordinance 51.09 – Rules Governing Use of Water Supply -Restricting water use. The Village Council may regulate, limit or prohibit the use of village supplied water for any purpose. The regulations may limit use of water by a user to the extent deemed necessary to assure an adequate supply of water for essential needs and fire fighting.

WHEREAS; Ordinance 51.10 – Establishment of Rates and Charges; *Fire hydrant rental charges*. Any person desiring to utilize any fire hydrant in the village shall make application to the village for the use, which application shall specify the hydrant or hydrants to be used, the length of time the hydrant(s) will be used and the purpose for which the hydrant(s) will be used. The application shall be accompanied by a non-refundable rental charge plus a cash deposit for a temporary meter in amounts established by resolution of the Village Council. The fire hydrant connection and meter installation shall be made by the village. A hydrant usage charge, calculated on the basis of metered gallons of water consumed, shall be assessed at rates determined by resolution of the Village Council. Upon expiration of the rental period, the village shall remove the connection and temporary meter. The cash deposit shall be applied by the village to the payment of the hydrant usage charge and the excess amount of the deposit, if any, shall be refunded to the applicant.

WHEREAS; the Village municipal water supply was designed to provide a commodity to village residents, property owners and commercial operators within the village limits;

WHERAS; the prevailing situation demands that it needs to be treated as a limited precious commodity to be distributed among the entire population equitably and efficiently.

WHEREAS; sound management of municipal water supplies to solve this problem depends on four fundamental principles: progressive pricing, effective metering, universal pipe connectivity and independent regulation.

WHEREAS; the sale of water for use outside the village is a burden on our water system and XXXXXXX;

WHEREAS; staff is requesting direction on how to determine acceptable sales and pricing for all uses;
