Monthly Report to Village Council December 2023

Listed below is a breakdown of the activity conducted by the members of the Pinckney Police Department during the month of December 2023.

During the month, officers performed 47 Subdivision Patrols, 36 Building/Area checks, and 15 assists to other agencies. We wrote 263 case reports this year which is slightly more than 2022. We responded to 3,547 calls for service for the calendar year.

We have continued training in subject control and de-escalation techniques with the Livingston County Training Consortium. Officer Stoehr attended Subject Control Instructor's Course. Sgt Trenkle and Ofc Prater attended the Critical Incident Supervision course from the National Tactical Officer's Association.

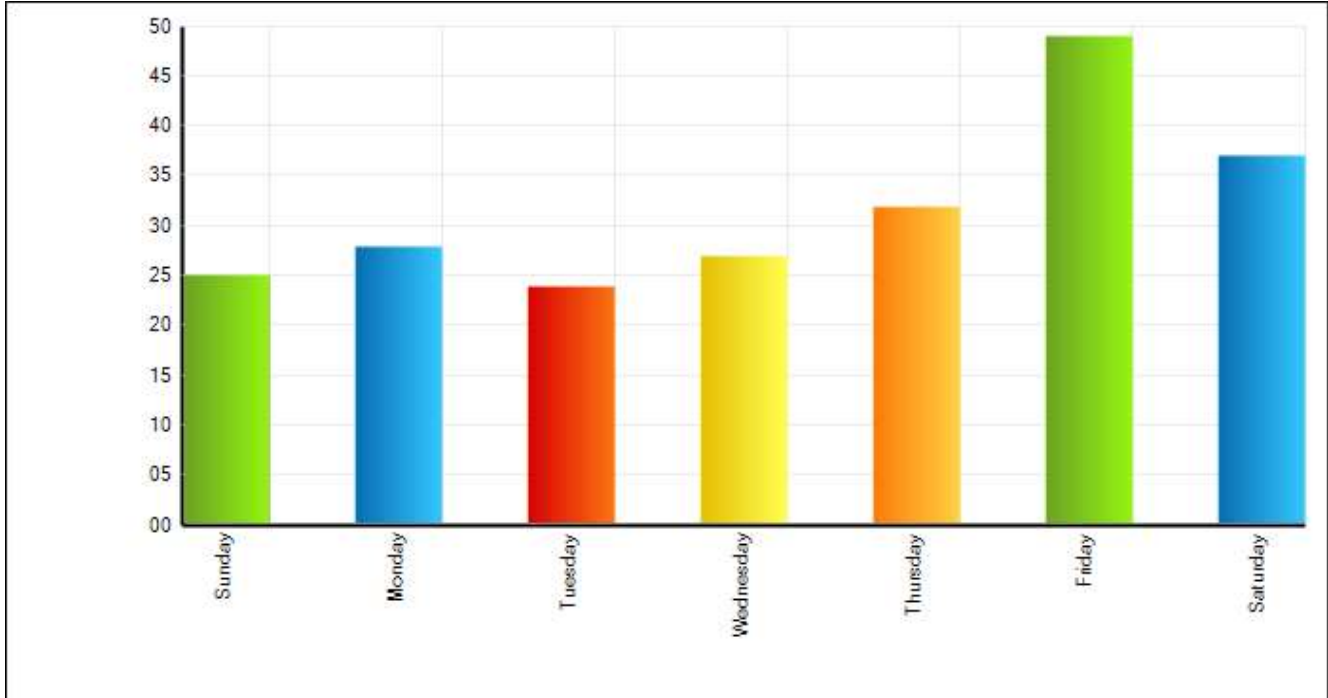

Re: Zoning Administrator's Report

Permits & Code Enforcement: Now that the cold weather is here, land use permits and waiver requests have decreased significantly. Please note the following since my last report:

- * 1 Land Use Permit was issued - generator
- * 5 Waivers were issued – all for re-roof

Planning Commission:

1. Training: New Commission Member Savanna Gee has been participating in the "Citizen Planner" on-line program through the MSU Extension and Alex Smith will be participating in "The Roles and Responsibilities of a Planning Commission" program along with Christine Oliver also through MSU Extension.
2. Final Site Plan Review – Lakeland Knoll – Progress Update: We are continuing to work with the developer and engineers to develop a plan for submission.
3. Northville Services & Holdings (Essence) has submitted for preliminary site plan review for a proposed Class A Marihuana facility. The provisional license for the Class A microbusiness has not yet been issued by the Clerk, however the Cannabis Committee is scheduled to meet on January 22nd to review the application.
4. The Means: A meeting was held on January 18th with President Lavey, staff and a representative of The Means. They intend to move forward with the project with a new general contractor as soon as some outstanding issues are resolved, including the watermain extension.

DDA:

1. N. Howell Street & E. Main Street Sidewalk, ramp & railing: In September, the DDA authorized the expenditure for a comprehensive site investigation by Wolverine Engineers to identify areas that require modifications to meet ADA requirements and to develop a full plan, etc. for a comprehensive project at the north east quadrant. The Board will be considering the proposal at their February meeting.

OTHER:

1. Redevelopment Ready Certification: We still have a few outstanding items to be complete before we can be re-certified as a Redevelopment Ready Community. While some of the items were simply updates, others have required new plans, written policy and significant changes. Most recently, we have completed the following:
 - Development of written procedures for site Plan Application Processing and internal review process
 - Clearly defined flow chart of the Planning Process for site plan, special land use and rezoning requests
 - Update of the Public Participation Plan (adopted by Village Council & will be incorporated into the Planning Commission by-laws)
2. Livingston County Planning is still looking for public input for their 2025 Livingston County Master Plan. A brief survey can be taken at Planning@livgov.com.
