TEMPORARY SIGNS PERMITTED BY DISTRICT

CBD	1 portable sidewalk sign * per ground floor commercial use	4 feet	6 square feet	12 square feet
SBD	4 per parcel	4 feet	6 square feet	12 square feet
ROB and O	4 per parcel	4 feet	6 square feet	12 square feet
RTO	4 per parcel	4 feet	6 square feet	12 square feet
PL	1 per parcel	6 feet	25 square feet	50 square feet

All temporary signs:

- 1) Shall be on private property only with property owner permission
- 2) Shall be non-illuminated
- 3) Shall be made of water-resistant materials
- 4) Shall not be located in a public right-of-way and located and designed to avoid interference with or distraction to vehicular and pedestrian traffic
- 5) Streamers, flags, etc. are strictly prohibited
- 6) All temporary signs shall be removed when weather conditions create potentially hazardous conditions
