Gorski will pick up tires and large items from side of roads as usual (may require extra trip(s)

Allocate \$5,800 of township funds toward total project:

\$3,300 for Gorski standard costs

\$500 for possible overrun

1,000 for kit supplies

\$500 for dumpsters

Village will split the cost of dumpsters and arrange pick up of trash bags in the Village
