Ordinance Description and Permit Regulations: Per Chapter 90.01 of the Village of Pinckney Ordinances, animals other than dogs and cats can be kept with approval of Village Council. Applicants must adhere to regulations outlined in Chapter 90.01 of the Village of Pinckney Ordinances. Village Council may revoke permit at anytime. Confirmed complaints of noise, smell, unsanitary conditions or other violation of Village Ordinances will result in revocation of permit and possible additional penalties. No roosters. Chickens must be kept in a fenced, secured enclosure. Chicken coops must be located in back yard and meet outbuilding setbacks (currently 20' from back lot line, 6" from side) if yard is not fenced; shed setbacks (5' from side and back lot lines) shall apply if yard is fenced, or as determined by Village Zoning Ordinance. Village Officials must approve coop location prior to chickens being housed. Initial permit issued on 6 month trial basis and can be renewed annually. No permits will be issued without the consent of ALL adjacent neighbors. Please attach neighbor consent forms for all adjacent property owners and renters. An adjacent property is defined as any property owner that comes in contact with the permit address at any point. If applicant is a renter, property owner must sign consent form. Attach a plot plan showing chicken coop location including distances from lot lines, buildings and streets.
